I believe in the Holy Spirit,  
the holy catholic\* church,  
the communion of saints,  
the forgiveness of sins,  
the resurrection of the body,  
and the life everlasting. Amen.

Although not written by the apostles, the APOSTLES' CREED is a concise summary of their teachings.  
It originated as a baptismal confession, probably in the second century, and developed into its present form by the  
sixth or seventh century.
