From the Gospels

LEADER: *You shall have no other gods before me.*

RESPONSE: It is written: "Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only."

LEADER: *You shall not make for yourself an idol.*

RESPONSE: God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in spirit and in truth.

LEADER: *You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God.*

RESPONSE: "Do not swear at all: either by heaven, for it is God's throne; or by the earth, for it is his footstool. . . . Let your 'Yes' be 'Yes', and your 'No,' 'No'; anything beyond this comes from the evil one."

LEADER: *Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.*

RESPONSE: The Sabbath was made for man, not man for the Sabbath. So the Son of Man is Lord even of the Sabbath.

LEADER: *Honor your father and your mother.*

RESPONSE: For God said, "Anyone who curses his father or mother must be put to death."

LEADER: *You shall not murder.*

RESPONSE: Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, that you may be sons of your Father in heaven.

LEADER: *You shall not commit adultery.*

RESPONSE: Anyone who looks at a woman lustfully has already committed adultery with her in his heart.

LEADER: *You shall not steal.*

RESPONSE: For out of the heart come evil thoughts, murder, adultery . . . theft . . . These are what make a man "unclean."

LEADER: *You shall not give false testimony.*

RESPONSE: For out of the overflow of the heart the mouth speaks. . . . For by your words you will be acquitted, and by your words you will be condemned.

LEADER: *You shall not covet.*

RESPONSE: Watch out! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; a man's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions.
