☞ **Welcome to Covenant Presbyterian Church!**

We are a congregation of the Orthodox Presbyterian Church and believe that God has brought us here to glorify Himself by reaching souls for Christ and building them up in holiness. We are delighted that you are with us today, and hope that you will let us know how we may serve you and your family. Our prayer is that the Holy Spirit would grow us into a holy church that will worship Him with reverence and awe and serve Him with joy.

☞ **Worship at CPC:** We believe worship is one of the most important things the church does. Our God is holy, beautiful, and awesome! We want our worship to be the same. Our goal is to have a musical style that is consistent with our theology. We are slowly developing a small, classical ensemble of instruments with a piano, violin, cello, and flute, etc. Please let our music coordinator know if you might be interested in playing an instrument.

☞ **Christian Education:** Our goal for Christian Education is to offer classes to various ages on various subjects. We currently have an adult Sunday school class and several Sunday school classes for children ages 3-7yrs and 8-12yrs.

☞ **Small Children:** While it is our desire to have our covenant kids with us in worship, we want those in need to have help available. A nursing room for nursing mothers, a cry room and a staffed nursery for children ages 0-30 months are located at the narthex. We also have children's worship service training for ages 2^{1/2}-4 years.

☞ **Book Table:** Our book table is located in the Narthex.. The church does not make a profit on these books; we simply recover the cost of buying them. Prices are on the inside cover

☞ **Servant-hood:** As a young church, there are many small services with which we need help (nursery, ushering, greeting, set up, maintenance projects, landscaping, etc.). Please let us know if you are interested in helping with these things as we seek to do them well.

☞ **Outdoor Safety:** Our church is enveloped by the beauty of woods and water. Please make sure your children are supervised at all time, especially near the pond behind the parking lot.
